



Dear Potential Applicant,

Thank you for showing interest in the post of Children and Families Minister at Lutterworth Church. We're excited about this role and who God might bring to serve with us.

The successful candidate will provide oversight and leadership for all our Under 11's work, co-ordinate and develop our volunteer teams and seek to expand our outreach into the community. They will join our staff team and help support and fulfil the church's vision to make disciples of Jesus.

There is some flexibility within the role to accommodate whoever God sends us. As such, the application lays out two options for applicants to choose from when applying.

1. **Associate Minister for Children and Families:** for someone with relevant training and experience who would join the senior leadership team of the church.
2. **Children and Families Worker:** more scope for personal and professional development including giving you time and financial assistance for further theological training.

Please indicate on the application which you will be applying for.

The closing date for applications will be Monday 16th March at 12 noon, with interviews being held on Sunday 29th and Monday 30th March.

If asked to attend an interview, you will be invited to our three Sunday services. You will be offered overnight accommodation and have the chance to meet members of our church family.

On the Monday, you will be asked to participate in our toddler group, Little Acorns, as well as three 40 minute interview panels. These will give us a chance to get to know you and what you would bring to the team, as well as exploring together whether this is a place you could flourish.

More details will be given about the panels if you are invited to an interview. Travel expenses incurred will be repaid by St Mary's PCC on proof of receipt.

Please be assured of our prayers as you discern whether Lutterworth is the place to which God is calling you.
