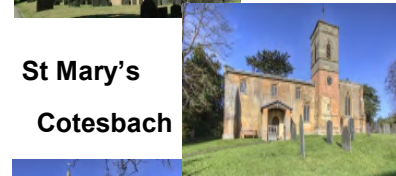

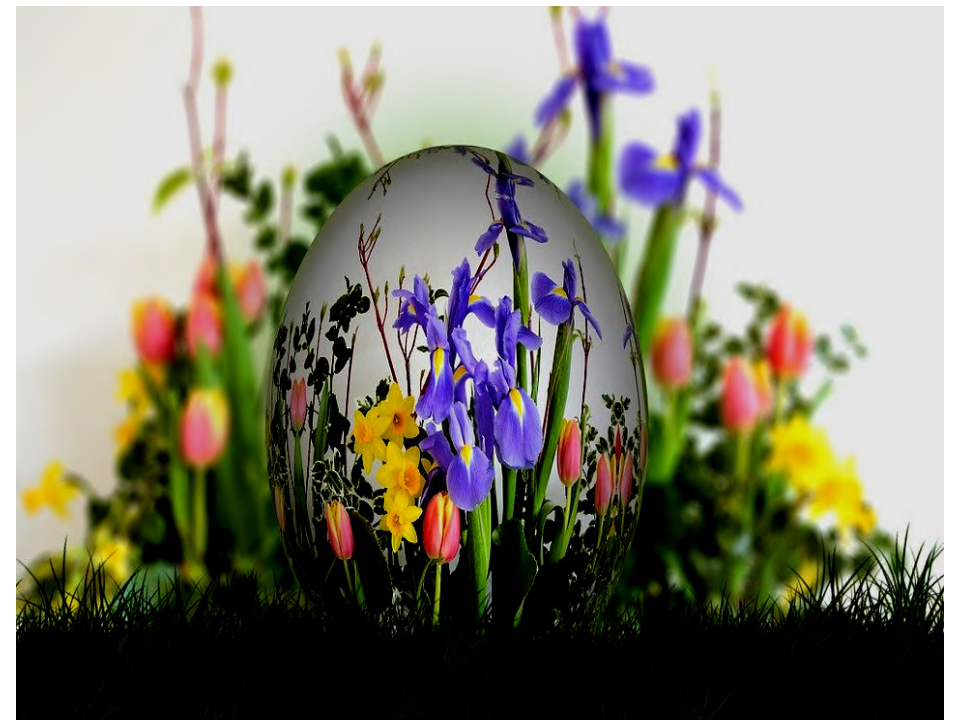

SUNDAY 12th APRIL

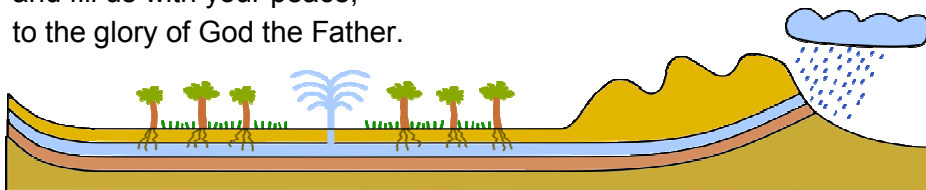
God of glory,

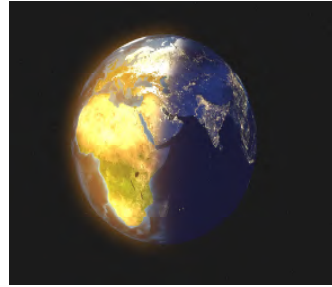

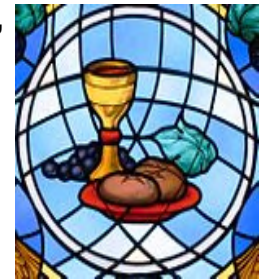
