We thank you that we are known to you by name and loved by you from all eternity. We thank you for Jesus Christ, who has opened to us the way of love.

We praise you, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

All: Blessed be God for ever.

4. THE BLESSING

The minister may take the child.

The minister prays for the parents:

May God the Father of all bless these parents and give them grace to love and care for their children.

May God give them wisdom, patience and faith, help them to provide for their children's needs and, by their example, reveal the love and truth that are in Jesus Christ.

Amen.

6. THE PROMISES

The minister addresses the supporting friends and says,

Will you do all that you can to help and support these parents in the bringing up of this child?

The Godparents: With the help of God, we will.

The minister addresses the church family and says,

Will you do all that you can to help and support this family? *All:* With the help of God, we will.
